Grantor in each case is "Matthias Painter, eldest son and heir at law of John Painter decd."


Notice that Matthias uses the surname "Bender" in the will but "Painter" in the deeds.

Each deed is granted to a specific son of Matthias and each deed is to a specific part of the land as specified in the above will.

Only one such deed is shown here as an example for each of the others.
