Uriah Clayton Herr was known as U.C. or "Clayt" Herr. He descended from a long line of Swiss Mennonites who original immigrant ancestor founded the Mennonite Church in Lancaster, Pennsylvania in 1710.

Clayt partnered with Charles Painter to purchase the Barber County Index newspaper in Medicine Lodge, Kansas. He married Charles' sister, Lillian, a typesetter at the newspaper. They had one son who died in infancy and two daughters both of whom survived to adulthood.

After retiring in the 1920's they came west first to Chehalis, Washington, then briefly to Ely, Nevada, where Clayt became Editor of the Ely Record, and finally to East Palo Alto, California where they ran a small chicken ranch and fruit and berry orchard.

Abraham Reider Herr was the first in his family to leave the Mennonite community in Pennsylvania. He took his family by train to Kiowa, Kansas in 1886. He bought land for a farm but died three years later. His sons attended school in Kiowa and tended the farm. Elizabeth remarried and had one more son. In 1893 her sons joined the famous 'run' for the Cherokee Strip. Son Allen led the charge and won a claim.

Abraham Herr and Anna Reider lived their lives among their Mennonite kin in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. Several of their sons later migrated west to Kansas.

Abraham descended from, Abraham, eldest son of the immigrant head of the Mennonite Church in Pennsylvania. Abraham Herr was born in 1660 in Switzerland to the Reverend Hans Herr and his wife Elizabeth Kendig. Abraham's son was also named Abraham and he too was born in Switzerland in 1700. His son, Christian was born in Manor, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania in 1746. Christian and his wife, Frances Martin, had a son named Abraham in 1771. Abraham married Maria Funk and had a son, Rudolph. Rudolph was the father of the subject of this family group sheet. Throughout this history in America, the family had migrated less than fifty miles from the original settlement.

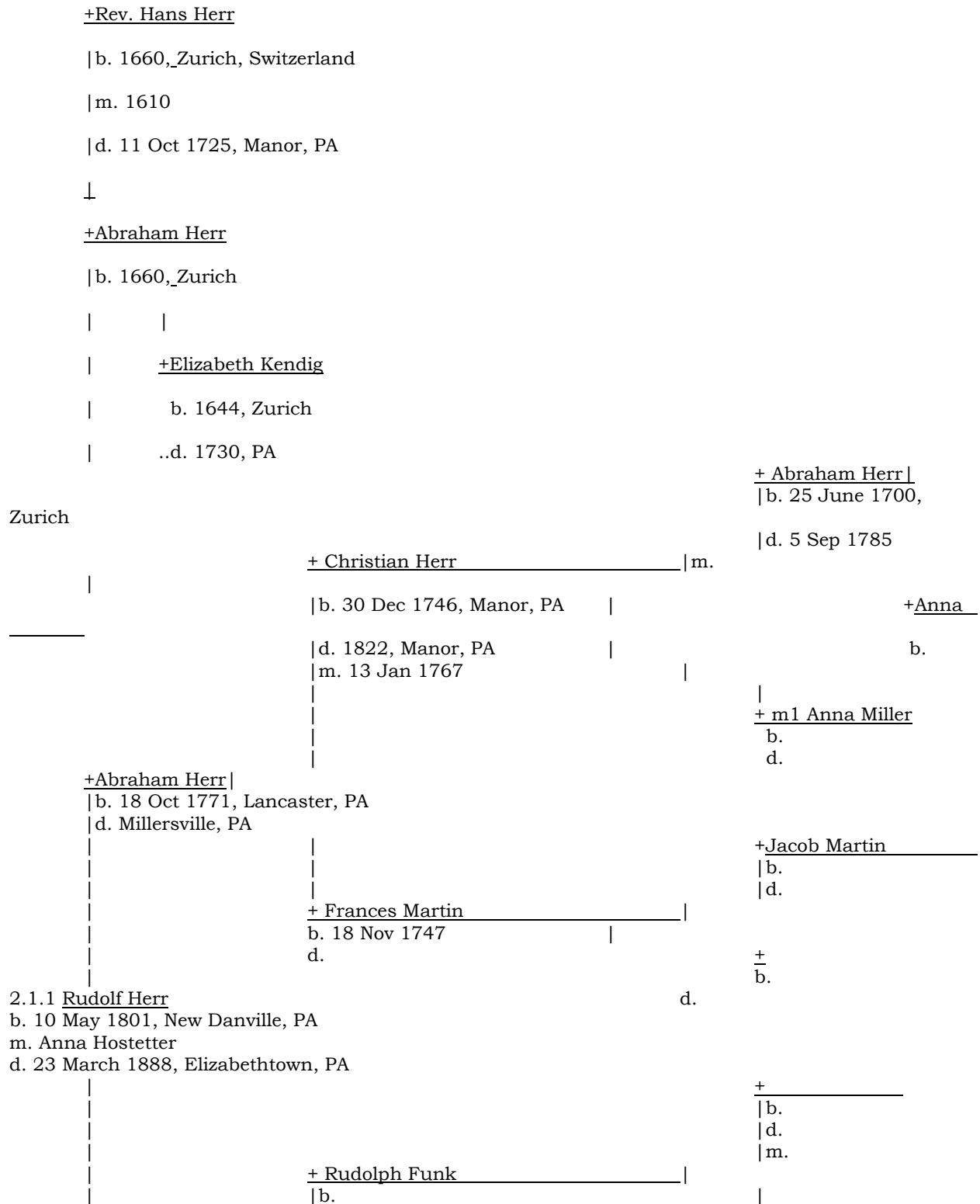
